

As you know, the health, safety and well-being of our children and staff are our highest priorities. Due to recent changes as set forth by Governor Wolf and Secretary Levine, and in order to comply fully with all federal, state and local rules, regulations and guidance, as well as guidance provided by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC); we are required to follow the mandated mask policy as set forth by the Governor and Secretary Levine.

Specifically, we are guided by Secretary Levine's July 1, 2020 [Order Requiring Universal Face Coverings](#), Governor Wolf's Order and July 9, 2020 [Frequently Asked Questions \(FAQ\)](#) regarding Summer Recreation, Camps and Pools, as well as [Allegheny County's July 3, 2020 COVID-19 Guidance](#) and [CDC's Suggestions for Youth and Summer Camps](#). Naturally, should any of these guidelines change due to evolving circumstances, we will adapt accordingly so as to stay in full compliance with governmental restrictions and best practices.

MASKS

Please note the following changes to our mask policy.

At CCGF Kids Ministry, masks are required* by all students, volunteers, and staff **2 years of age and older**. Masks are required* to be worn while students, volunteers, and staff participate in any indoor activity.

*In compliance with Governor Wolf's [Order Requiring Universal Face Coverings](#) Section 3 states the following are exceptions to the face covering requirement:

- Individuals who cannot wear a mask due to a medical condition, including those with respiratory issues that impede breathing, mental health condition, or disability;
- Individuals who would be unable to remove a mask without assistance;
- Individuals who are under two years of age;
- Individuals who are communicating or seeking to communicate with someone who is hearing-impaired or has another disability, where the ability to see the mouth is essential for communication;
- Individuals are not required to show documentation that an exception applies.

CLEANLINESS

At CCGF Kids Ministry, volunteers, both adults and teens, as well as students will be encouraged to:

- Refrain from hugging, or otherwise physically touching another.
- Wash hands for 20 seconds or longer frequently and always after toileting.
- Maintain social distance when possible and feasible.
- Wear a mask in order with the above policy.

Additionally, rooms and bathrooms will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized before every program.

ANY STUDENT, VOLUNTEER, OR STAFF PERSON WHO HAS:

- Come into contact with someone who has COVID or is unwell,
 - Is not feeling well,
 - Or has a fever Of 100.4 or higher,
- Is asked to stay home.
