

Hello Parents!

As you know, the health, safety and well-being of our children and staff are our highest priorities. Due to recent changes as set forth by Governor Wolf and Secretary Levine, and in order to comply fully with all federal, state and local rules, regulations and guidance, as well as guidance provided by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC); we are required to make changes to our previously communicated mask policy.

Specifically, we are guided by Secretary Levine's July 1, 2020 [Order Requiring Universal Face Coverings](#), Governor Wolf's Order and July 9, 2020 [Frequently Asked Questions \(FAQ\)](#) regarding Summer Recreation, Camps and Pools, as well as [Allegheny County's July 3, 2020 COVID-19 Guidance](#) and [CDC's Suggestions for Youth and Summer Camps](#). Naturally, should any of these guidelines change due to evolving circumstances, we will adapt accordingly so as to stay in full compliance with governmental restrictions and best practices.

MASKS

Please note the following changes to our mask policy. The below policy supersedes the policy that was emailed and mailed on July 15, 2020.

At CCGF Summer Day Camp, masks are required* by all campers, volunteers, and staff over 2 years of age. Masks are required* to be worn while campers, volunteers, and staff participate in any indoor activity. All campers, volunteers, and staff must also wear a mask outside whenever they are within six (6) feet of any other camper, volunteer, or staff person. Face masks may be removed only when campers, volunteers, and staff are outside and maintaining a social distance of six (6) feet.

1. All individuals (campers, volunteers, and staff) are required* to wear a face mask while participating in outdoor activities when a distance of 6 feet cannot be maintained between other campers, volunteers, or staff.
2. A mask is not required during outdoor activities when a 6ft distance between other campers, staff, and volunteers is maintained.

*In compliance with Governor Wolf's [Order Requiring Universal Face Coverings](#) Section 3 states the following are exceptions to the face covering requirement:

- Individuals who cannot wear a mask due to a medical condition, including those with respiratory issues that impede breathing, mental health condition, or disability;
- Individuals who would be unable to remove a mask without assistance;
- Individuals who are under two years of age;
- Individuals who are communicating or seeking to communicate with someone who is hearing-impaired or has another disability, where the ability to see the mouth is essential for communication;

- Individuals are not required to show documentation that an exception applies.

GROUPINGS

At CCGF Summer Day Camp, campers will be in the same small group with the same leaders to the greatest extent possible. Some interaction between campers of different groups may occur during opening and closing ceremonies and at game times.

CLEANLINESS

At CCGF Summer Day Camp, volunteers, both adults and teens, as well as campers will be encouraged to:

- Refrain from hugging, or otherwise physically touching another.
- Wash hands for 20 seconds or longer frequently and always after toileting.
- Maintain social distance when possible and feasible.
- Wear a mask in order with the above policy.

ANY CAMPER, VOLUNTEER, OR STAFF PERSON WHO HAS:

- Come into contact with someone who has COVID or is unwell,
- Is not feeling well,
- Or has a fever of 100.4 or higher,

Is asked to stay home.

While many parents are comfortable with the precautions we are taking, we understand that others might feel differently and would only feel comfortable if additional precautions are taken above and beyond those required by the governments or recommended by the CDC. In these uncertain times, we completely understand that sentiment. We are therefore pleased to offer our Summer Day Camp virtually, and we would be more than happy to enroll your child in our Virtual Camp, should you wish.
